Eligibility: For all the above three programmes, minimum 3-year Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in any discipline, with at least 50% marks in aggregate, from a recognised university/deemed university. Final year degree students, completing their final examinations by June 15, 2012 can also apply.

Admission Test: For PGDM and PGDM-HRM, all applicants are required to appear for any one of the following tests:

a) XAT to be conducted by XLRI on January 8, 2012, or b) CAT to be conducted by IIMs during 22 October- 18 November 2011. For PGDM-RM, all applicants are required to appear for any one of the following tests: a) XAT-2012, or b) CAT-2011, or c) IRMA Test to be conducted by Institute of Rural Management, Anand, on November 13, 2011. Applicants have to follow XAT/CAT/IRMA advertisements respectively and apply in time, before separately applying to XIMB.
